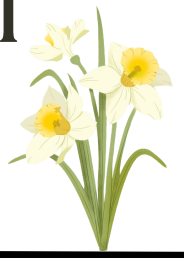

Church Wall and Tree Removal

As reported in a previous newsletter, the church wall has become unsafe and requires attention. As part of the necessary work to address this issue, one of the trees adjacent to the wall will be taken down at the end of March.

The Parish Council take the removal of trees in our village very seriously. However, the condition of the wall has now made the situation unsafe, and public safety must remain the priority.

The wall will be rebuilt once sufficient funds become available.

The wood from the tree will be cut into logs and offered to village residents at a reasonable price. All proceeds will go to The Friends of Ludborough Church to help support the ongoing work and maintenance of the church.

Footpath and Footbridge Closure



The footpath and footbridge beside the church, which lead to the fields behind, are currently closed. This matter is being dealt with by Highways, and we have been informed that the route will remain closed until further notice.

The bank has eroded, which led to the collapse of the bridge. The bridge has now been removed and taken away for repair. We appreciate residents' patience while the necessary work is carried out and will provide updates when more information becomes available.
